Directions:

Find best route to I-84, From East take Exit 34 (Route 372 – Crooked St.). Turn left onto Crooked Street. Take a left at light onto New Britain Ave. (Route 372 West). Laurel Lanes will be on the left side in 0.7 miles.

From West take Exit 33 (Route 72 toward Plainville). Take exit 2 (Route 372 / New Britain Ave.). Turn left onto New Britain Ave. / Route 372. Center is in 0.2 miles.

(SEE RULE 6)**

Tournament Rules

1. All entrants must be CT State USBC league members. No unattached membership will be available at the tournament site.
2. This tournament is a handicap tournament with a scratch division in accordance with rule #17. The Handicap will be 100% of 220. Scratch bowlers must declare their intention to bowl scratch on their entry form. All undeclared division entries will be placed in the appropriate handicap division.
3. Entering average is based upon the following:
 - a. Highest Current Average with at least 9 games as of February 6, 2012 per USBC Rule 318. **(Average sheet is mandatory)**
If no current average is available use the following:
 - b. Highest USBC Certified Average posted during the 2010/2011 season with 21 games or more.
 - c. Highest 2011 summer average with 21 games or more. **(Average sheet mandatory)**
 - d. No verifiable average the bowler would then bowl scratch.
4. USBC Rules and Regulations will cover any rules not covered herein. The tournament director shall rule on all other matters. This event is USBC Youth Certified.
5. Entries – multiple entries will be permitted. Only one award may be earned with the same partner. A bowler may enter as a team member on a maximum of two teams, providing that not more than two (2) of the same members are participating on each team. (First team score counts towards All Events.) No Bowler shall be permitted to enter or bowl more than once in singles event unless they are entering the scratch and handicap division. Bowlers may enter doubles a maximum of two times with different partners. (First doubles score counts towards All Events.)
6. All Walk-Ins and substitutes must report one (1) hour earlier than squad time. **(Cash is required for all walk-in bowlers.)**
7. All bowlers will bowl three (3) games in each event. A bowler must bowl team, doubles and singles to qualify for All Events. First event scores count towards all-events.
8. If in either team or doubles event, a duly scheduled entrant is unable to bowl, the tournament director will have the right to substitute a bowler, providing the substitute meets all other requirements. The bowler must be able to provide his or her average in accordance with rule #3. Replacements and substitution will be in accordance with USBC tournament rules and regulations.
9. All registered entrants must report 30 minutes before scheduled time of bowling to official in charge of lane assignments.
10. In case of disability after a game is started, a substitute will be allowed, if one is available and the combined scores to count. Handicap shall be awarded per USBC rule 107c.
11. Bowlers are responsible for entering the proper average, age, and present their USBC membership card at check in. See rule #3 entering average. Falsification will result in disqualification of the bowler and/or team.
12. No refunds of entry fee will be made after entry has been processed and squad time assigned. Entry fee must accompany entry and entry fees for bad checks and any charges must be paid in cash, bank check or money order prior to bowling. All checks should be made payable to: CT State USBC Association. **There will be a \$30.00 charge for all returned checks.**
13. Entrants shall not be permitted to leave the bowling settee area without permission of a tournament official.
14. Awards fee will be returned 100%. In the event there are less than six (6) entries in any division, entrants may be moved to another division at the discretion of the tournament director. Only one (1) All-event award will be given to an individual; however, in the event an individual wins both, the handicap & scratch All-event award will be engraved to show both honors. First event score counts towards All-Events. Champion awards will be given to first place in each division. Scratch division will bowl as a separate declared division.
15. In addition to Divisional championships, a total of four (4) scholarships will be awarded to the All-Events champion for Scratch & Handicap, Male & Female. Minimum awards will be \$500 for Handicap All-Events, \$250 for Scratch All-Events. To be eligible, a bowler must be a current CT State USBC active member. Should the overall champion not be eligible, the scholarship will be awarded to the runner-up. The USBC Smart program will administer all monies.
16. In the event of ties for first place, co-champions will be declared and duplicate awards will be given. In the event of ties for the Scholarship, a roll-off will be scheduled, with date, time and place to be determined by the tournament director, within 2 weeks of the posting of the final results. For all other positions, the awards fund allocated for two successive positions will be combined and duplicate awards will be given.
17. Divisions shall be based on the average as stated in Rule #3. There will be no scratch team event unless a minimum of 6 scratch teams sign up.

18. Any appeal or protest regarding scores must be made in writing and be submitted to the tournament director no later than 24 hours after the game has been played, briefly stating grounds for appeal or protest.
19. Any other appeal or protest must be made in writing, briefly stating grounds of appeal or protest and be submitted to the tournament director no later than 72 hours after the infraction.
20. Competitors shall provide their own bowling shirt with a butterfly collar or mock collar. Mock collar must be one inch up on the neck. All shirts must have finished sleeves. Females may wear a sleeveless shirt with a butterfly collar only if the sleeves are finished. The USBC Youth Shirt is recommended. A t-shirt promoting either a league, bowling center or bowling equipment is allowed. Appropriate shorts (no more than two inches above the knee) will be permitted. **Gym shorts, short shorts, basketball type shorts, and sweat pants will NOT be permitted.** Jeans (no holes) are allowed. No head covering (**hats, caps, bandannas, etc.**) or sunglasses can be worn while practicing or competing. The tournament manager must approve any/all exceptions prior to the event. All clothing worn should be appropriate for all ages.
21. Electronic devices (headphones, cell phones, ipods, etc.) can only be used in the settee area. They cannot be used while bowling nor cause a delay of game. If either occurs, a warning will be issued at the discretion of the Tournament director, followed by forfeiture of frames and/ or games if necessary, per USBC Rule 11.
22. In the event not enough bowlers enter the scratch events, the tournament director will combine the division with the highest handicap division in the appropriate segment (boys, girls and mixed) Scratch All-events score will be counted from these declared bowlers towards there scratch all-event scores. If less than ten (10) bowlers declare the scratch division, scholarships funds will be increased in the handicap divisions to \$500 instead of the stated \$250.

NOTE: A VOLUNTEER SCOREKEEPER AND MONITOR MAY BE REQUIRED FOR EACH PAIR OF LANES
