

**CT STATE USBCA INSTRUCTION FORM  
HALL OF FAME NOMINEES**

1. To submit the name of a candidate for the Hall of Fame, complete the nomination form and return to the Chairman of the Hall of Fame Committee no later than February 15th.
2. Any member in good standing may submit a nomination in any of the categories
  - a) Candidates shall sign and date nomination form as well as Local Association Manager signifying accuracy and approval.
3. SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE
  - a) Candidates shall have bowled for at least Fifteen (15) years in a State Association and be at least forty (40) years of age.
4. MERITORIOUS SERVICE
  - a) Candidates shall have distinguished themselves through outstanding service with at least fifteen (15) years of service in a State Association and at least forty (40) years of age.
5. COMBINED SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE AND MERITORIOUS SERVICE
  - a) Candidates shall have distinguished themselves through outstanding Superior Performance and Meritorious Service in a State Association for at least fifteen (15) years and be at least forty (40) years of age.
6. FRIENDS OF BOWLING (could include proprietors, media, old timers, friend of bowling and honorary)
  - a) Candidates may have qualifications from each of the regular categories but not required. They must submit resume to the Chairman of the Hall of Fame Committee with the approval of the Local Association manager. All items to be considered shall have occurred within the State of Connecticut.
7. Nominations are reviewed thoroughly by the State Hall of Fame Committee for eligibility and completeness, but final selection is made by the Connecticut State USBCA Board of Directors.
8. Nomination forms of qualified candidates will be maintained in the active file for two (2) years and reviewed annually.
9. It is not necessary to submit a new nomination form annually, but updates are essential.
