Dear Director of Guidance:

The CT State USBC Association is once again seeking applicants for their two academic scholarships. The applicant does NOT need to be an active bowler. For the first available scholarship, the student, parent or grandparent must be a current member of the Connecticut State USBC Association. For the second scholarship, the student's mother or grandmother must be a current member of the Connecticut State USBC Association. This scholarship is from the former Connecticut State Women's Bowling Association. For both scholarships, the student must be a senior who is planning to continue his/her education in the summer or fall.

The amount of each scholarship is \$1000.00. The winners should plan to attend our Youth Awards Festival in June 2017.

I am asking your assistance in promoting this scholarship to your senior students; however, there are a few points that I need to stress. All documentation **must** be postmarked by March **15**, **2017**. All transcripts of grades, including **First Semester Grades** must be included with the application as well as one letter of recommendation. A guidance counselor or appropriate school official **must sign the front of the application**.

Please remind the student, that, if he or she is selected as a finalist, an interview by the scholarship committee will be required. The chairman of the committee will contact the student to set up this interview. If you have any questions about the scholarships, please contact me at (860) 779-1649. Please make as many copies of the application as you may need. There are two scholarships, but only one form is required. Thank you for your time and effort on behalf of the Connecticut State USBC Association.
