MERITORIOUS SERVICE

Candidates must have an outstanding record of service to Ten Pin Bowling for a minimum of fifteen (15) years unless illness or injury or death had shortened their service. A Letter from a doctor is required for illness or injury.

Meritorious may be defined as having the qualities of leadership, innovation, creativity, initiative, dedication, enthusiasm and commitment. Longevity is not necessarily a deciding factor.

List offices held on National or State Board of Directors – USBCA / WIBC / ABC / CT USBCA / CSBA / CWBA / AJBC and Length of Service.

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List all CT USBCA / CSBA / CWBA / AJBC committees served on, i.e. Nominating, Queens Tournament Princess Tournament, Credentials, Ad Hoc Committees, Tellers, Assistant Sergeant-at-arms, etc. and length of service.

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Other Work at State Level: (AJBC / YABA / 600 Club, 500 Club, Connecticut Bowling Council, etc. Office(s) held and length of service.

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Other Work at National Level: List other organizations – AJBC, YABA, WASA, NEWBA, NEBA, Pioneer Club, 700 Club, 600 Club, 500 Club, State Membership Coordinator, etc. Offices held etc. and length of service

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Local: Offices held on Local Association Board of Directors – Length of service in each office.

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Local: List all Local Association Committees served on – Tournament, Nominating, Audit, BVL, Tellers, Assistant Sergeant-at-arms, etc. and length of service.

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Honors Won at either Local or State Level: Hall of Fame, Director of the Year, etc. and year received.
